Outdoor Warning Sirens

The updated outdoor warning system will feature the following alert tone protocol:

Tornado Warning - where radar or spotters have sighted a tornado in your area - alert tone will remain steady for a duration of 3 minutes

Severe Thunderstorm Warning - involving winds of at least 58 mph and/or hail of 1" or greater - alert tone will remain steady for a duration of 3 minutes

General Information

ACH Bank Draft

The City of Josephine now offers ACH bank draft for all utility accounts. To set up automated clearing house (ACH), a bank draft authorization form must be provided to the City of Josephine Utility Billing Department. The form is available on the Water Department page on the city website. There is NO fee to pay by ACH bank draft. ACH bank draft will run on the 10th of the month or the following business day.

Watering Guidelines

Effective April 1 to October 31

Sunday & Wednesday

Residential properties with **odd**-numbered addresses (ending in 1,3,5,7,9)

Tuesday & Saturday

Residential properties with **even**-numbered addresses (ending in 2,4,6,8)

Monday & Thursday

Non-residential properties (business/HOA common areas)

Friday

No residential or business watering unless exceptions apply

- ★ Landscape watering by automatic sprinklers is **prohibited between 10am and 6pm.**
- ★ Foundations and landscaping (shrubs, trees, etc.) may be watered for up to 2 hours **any day** by **hand-held hose or soaker hose only.**
- ★ Newly planted sod may be watered more than 2 times per week for up to 30 days, but no water runoff is permitted, and watering is prohibited between 10am and 6pm.
- ★ Adjust sprinklers to **avoid overwatering** and **excessive runoff.** Check your setting to make sure you are watering on your assigned day and in the cool of the morning or night.
