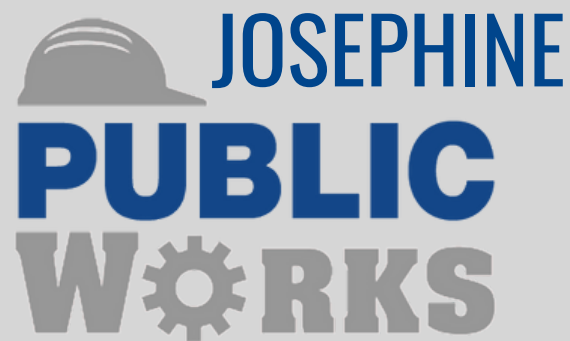

Native Plants can attract pollinators like hummingbirds, butterflies and bees. They are beautiful, Texas summer tough and need very little water.

TIPS TO SET YOUR LAWN UP FOR SUCCESS

- Check your sprinklers regularly for leaks
- Utilize My Water Advisor 2.0 to monitor daily usage
- Never water more than 2x per week even in the summer months
- In the summer months, raise your mower a bit to help retain water. Never cut off more than 1/3 of the grass blade.

Watering Guidelines

Effective April 1 to October 31

Sunday & Wednesday

Residential properties with **odd**-numbered addresses (ending in 1,3,5,7,9)

Tuesday & Saturday

Residential properties with **even**-numbered addresses (ending in 2,4,6,8)

Monday & Thursday

Non-residential properties (business/HOA common areas)

Friday

No residential or business watering unless exceptions apply

- ★ Landscape watering by automatic sprinklers is **prohibited between 10am and 6pm.**
- ★ Foundations and landscaping (shrubs, trees, etc.) may be watered for up to 2 hours **any day** by **hand-held hose or soaker hose only.**
- ★ Newly planted sod may be watered more than 2 times per week for up to 30 days, but no water runoff is permitted, and watering is prohibited between 10am and 6pm.
- ★ Adjust sprinklers to **avoid overwatering** and **excessive runoff.** Check your setting to make sure you are watering on your assigned day and in the cool of the morning or night.
