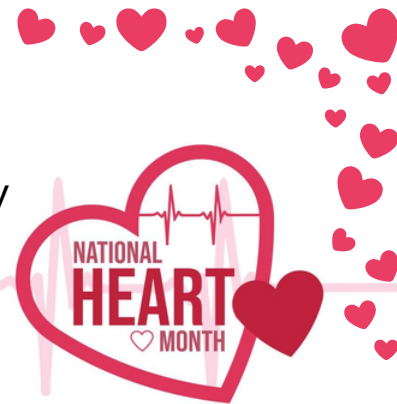

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JOSEPHINE POLICE DEPARTMENT

At the City Council meeting, Chief Graham recognized four Josephine Police Officers for their response to a missing child who was rescued from a pond before any injury occurred. Each officer received a Life Saving Award, which is presented when an officer's actions during an emergency directly prevent the loss of life.

On January 18, 2026, officers with the Josephine Police Department responded to a disturbance call involving unknown individuals attempting to forcibly enter a residence on Millstead Rill Drive within the Riverfield Municipal Utility District. Through detailed review of the video evidence and an extensive neighborhood canvass, officers were able to identify the suspects involved.

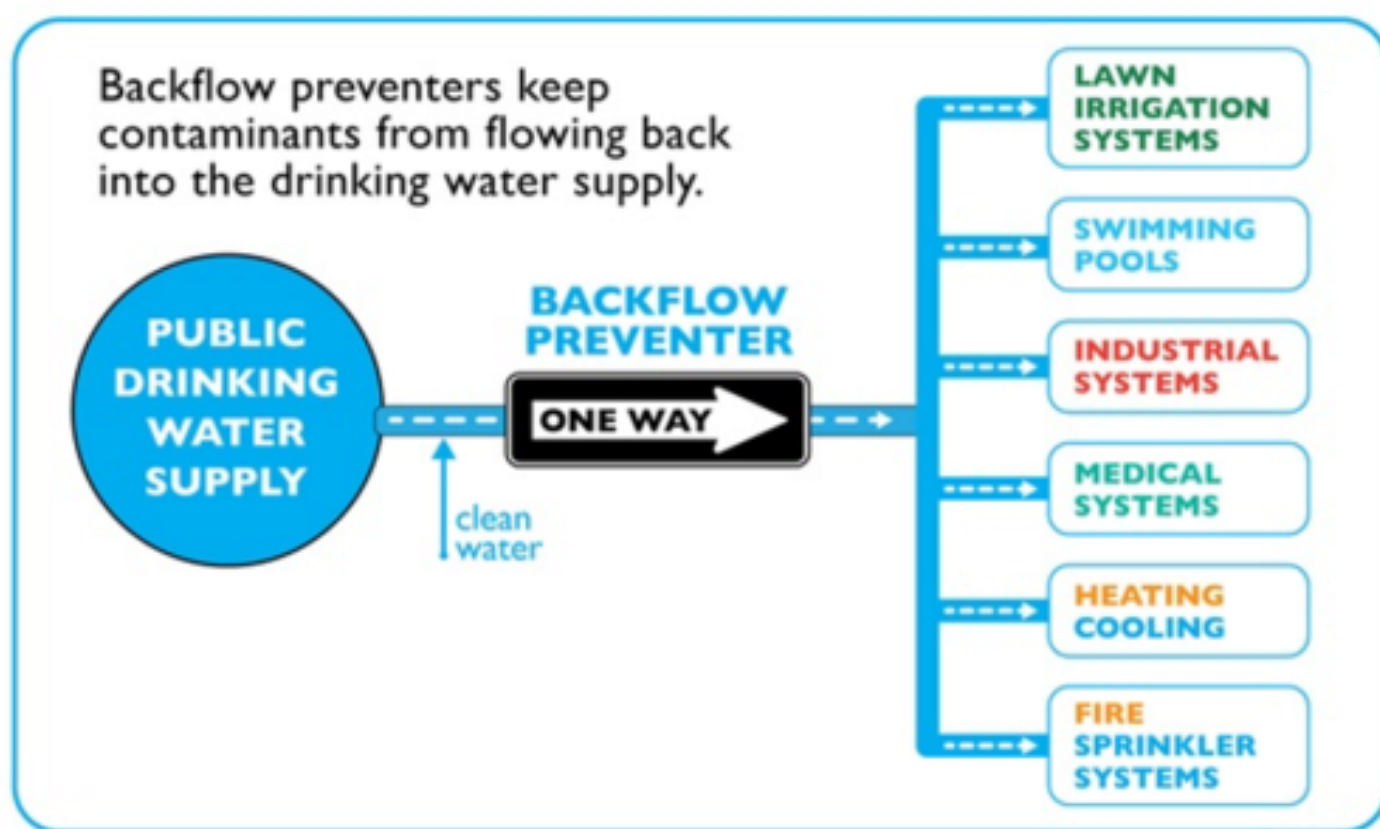

Regulated by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), NBU follows strict standards to ensure that the public drinking water supply remains safe.



Our customers have a responsibility to help keep the public water supply safe. If a source of water exists on your property, like an irrigation system or a pool, the possibility for contamination is there.

Residential must be tested upon installation and at least every 3 years. Additional testing may be required depending on the health hazard.
