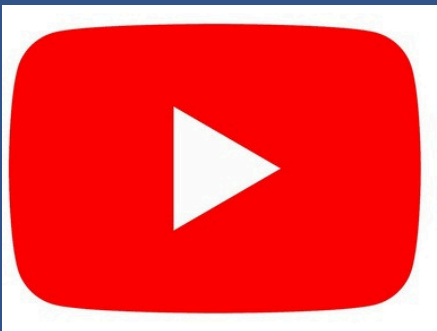
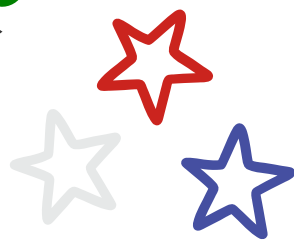
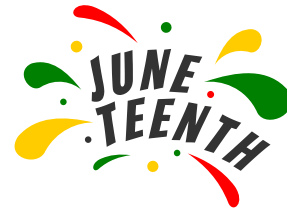

Important Notice About Online Utility Payments Effective June 15, 2026

The City of Josephine has been notified that our payment provider will re-implement additional fraud-prevention security measures for online payments.

To ensure your payments process successfully, customers will need to update any saved debit or credit cards in the payment portal.

What you need to do IF you pay by CARD for your utility bill:

1. Log into the online payment portal
2. Delete your saved card
3. Re-enter the card using the EXACT billing address and ZIP code listed with your card issuing financial institution

Payments may decline if the address does not match your bank records. This includes:

- Abbreviations (St. vs Street)
- Capitalization for State abbreviation (TX)
- Old addresses
- Only entering a ZIP code
- P.O. Box vs physical address differences

This security feature helps prevent fraudulent transactions and unauthorized use of cards.

Important:

Multiple payment attempts can cause temporary pending holds at your bank account. These are not additional charges and typically disappear within 3–5 business days depending on your bank.

Thank you for your cooperation in helping protect your account.

The Josephine Police Department reminds residents to take simple precautions to help keep our community safe. Always lock your home, garage, and vehicles, remove valuables from plain sight, and keep exterior lights on at night. If you notice suspicious activity, report it by calling 972-547-5350 for non-emergencies or 911 for emergencies. The Josephine Public Safety Building is open Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. for administrative matters; however, emergency situations should always be reported by calling 911.

JOSEPHINE FIRE DEPARTMENT

The Josephine Fire Department encourages residents to take a few simple steps to help keep their homes and families safe. Check smoke alarms regularly, have a family escape plan in place, and never leave cooking unattended. When using grills or outdoor fires, keep them away from structures and always supervise them.

During the summer months, remember to stay hydrated, avoid prolonged exposure to extreme heat, and check on vulnerable family members and pets. Also, make sure your address numbers are clearly visible from the street so emergency responders can locate your home quickly. If you notice a non-emergency fire hazard or safety concern, please call 972-547-5350. For emergencies, always call 911.

JOSEPHINE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT

The Public Works Department is pleased to report that the road rehabilitation project on Milton and Caddo Street has been successfully completed. These improvements will help provide a smoother and safer driving experience for residents and visitors.

Construction along Greenville Avenue is nearing completion, with the project currently estimated at 95% finished. Final work is underway, and the department looks forward to fully opening the improved roadway soon.

Along Main Street/FM 547, TXDOT crews are completing the final stages of roadway construction. These improvements will enhance traffic flow and support continued growth throughout the community.

Additionally, the gas company is preparing to install the final gas lines through town. This work represents an important step toward completing ongoing infrastructure upgrades that will benefit residents for years to come.

Mosquito Spraying Notice

Monday, March 23, 2026

The City will begin mosquito spraying on all streets within city limits.

Spraying will occur every Monday around dusk until further notice to help reduce mosquito activity throughout the community.

The spraying process uses cold fogging, which disperses into the air and can reach up to 300 feet for effective coverage.

There is no danger to pets from the spraying. However, as a precaution, residents may choose to bring pets and pet food bowls indoors during spraying times.

The cold fog treatment is safe and effective.
