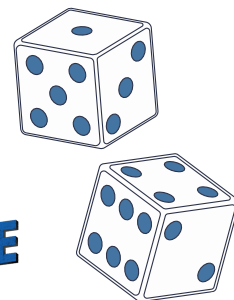

Our Public Works Department has been busy working on several projects and improvements throughout Josephine this month. Crews are working on drainage improvements along County Road 642 to help improve water flow in the area. A water main was also repaired at the intersection of FM 6 and FM 2606 to help maintain reliable water service for our residents.



In Liberty Ranch, Public Works is upgrading street signs throughout the neighborhood to improve visibility and consistency. Additionally, Wildflower MUD has begun dirt work as development continues in the area.

Josephine residents, there's still plenty of summer fun left! Be sure to stop by the Splash Pad at the Josephine City park and enjoy it throughout the month of August. The Splash Pad will officially close for the season on Labor Day, September 7th. Don't worry the Splash Pad will reopen on Memorial Day 2027!

Mosquito Spraying Notice

Monday, March 23, 2026

The City will begin mosquito spraying on all streets within city limits.

Spraying will occur every Monday around dusk until further notice to help reduce mosquito activity throughout the community.

The spraying process uses cold fogging, which disperses into the air and can reach up to 300 feet for effective coverage.

There is no danger to pets from the spraying. However, as a precaution, residents may choose to bring pets and pet food bowls indoors during spraying times.

The cold fog treatment is safe and effective.
