Meeting Details

- On August 10th, City Council will discuss and vote on adopting the annual budget, which guides how funds are allocated for city services, capital projects, and community needs.
- The Master Fee Schedule, which sets rates for services such as water, sewer, trash, public safety fees, and building permits, will be discussed, considered, and voted on during the August 10th City Council meeting.
- The proposed tax rate will be discussed on August 7th, and City Council will vote on setting a public hearing date for the tax rate.

JOSEPHINE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT

The Public Works Department has been hard at work completing projects that improve City infrastructure, enhance public safety, and maintain community spaces. This month, crews continued drainage improvements along CR 640 to help improve water flow and reduce drainage concerns throughout the area. They installed a new Safe Exchange Zone sign at the Public Safety Building, providing residents with a designated location for secure online purchase exchanges. In addition, crews have been actively repairing and replacing damaged street signs throughout the city to improve visibility and roadway safety.

Mosquito Spraying Notice

Monday, March 23, 2026

The City will begin mosquito spraying on all streets within city limits.

Spraying will occur every Monday around dusk until further notice to help reduce mosquito activity throughout the community.

The spraying process uses cold fogging, which disperses into the air and can reach up to 300 feet for effective coverage.

There is no danger to pets from the spraying. However, as a precaution, residents may choose to bring pets and pet food bowls indoors during spraying times.

The cold fog treatment is safe and effective.
